

## PLANNING YOUR TRIP TO CZECH REPUBLIC

You should check regularly the public health advice, document requirements and COVID-19 restrictions that are in place in the country.

### Conditions of entry into the Czech Republic

When planning, it is important where you come from and where you spent more than 12 hours in last 14 days. The individual countries are divided by colour according to the degree of risk of infection ("traffic lights" system). If you are traveling from a country that is not part of the EU+ countries, then check whether you are authorized to enter the country.

### EU+ citizens

Persons travelling from the country with a **low and medium risk** are obliged to fill in the **Passenger Locator Form and undergo an antigen or PCR test before arrival.**

Travellers from the countries with a **high and a very high risk** are obliged to fill in the **Passenger Locator Form, to submit negative PCR test before arrival** (when travelling by public transport) **and undergo a PCR test on the 5th day after the arrival at the earliest.** Until receiving a negative result of the test, it is **necessary to self-isolate.**

### Exception from testing and self-isolation for EU+ citizens:

- **Persons who had COVID-19 in the last 180 days** (it is necessary to have a written medical certificate from EU+ country where the isolation was completed or a digital EU certificate on it).
- **Persons fully vaccinated in the EU+ countries** after at least 14 days from the application of the last dose (it is necessary to have digital EU certificate – Covid Pass / Green Pass).
- **Czech citizens and EU+ citizens fully vaccinated in a third country** with the EMA approved vaccination after at least 14 days from the application of the last dose

(it is necessary to have a certificate whose sample is published on the Ministry of Health's website)

Third country citizens (out of EU+):

Persons travelling from the country with a **low risk** are obliged to fill in the **Passenger Locator Form and undergo an antigen or PCR test before arrival.**

Travellers WITH A SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION (according the exception from the measures) from the countries with a **medium, high and a very high risk** are obliged to fill in the **Passenger Locator Form, to submit negative PCR test before arrival** (when travelling by public transport) and undergo a **PCR test on the 5th day after the arrival at the earliest.** Until receiving a negative result of the test, it is **necessary to self-isolate.**

Third-country nationals not listed as countries with a low risk of COVID-19 or without the special authorization cannot enter the Czech Republic.

**BEFORE TRAVELLING TO CZECH REPUBLIC**

- **Double-check the above entry rules**
- **fill in the Passenger Locator form <https://plf.uzis.cz/>  
That is obligatory for every traveller entering the Czech Republic.**
- **Take a test** (PCR not longer than 72 hours before starting the travel or Antigen test not longer than 48 hours before starting the travel)

OR

- **Prepare your documents according to the exceptions from testing or self-isolation** (only EU+ countries citizens)
  - Persons who had COVID-19 in the last 180 days (it is necessary to have a written medical certificate from EU+ country where the isolation was completed or a digital EU certificate on it).
  - Persons fully vaccinated in the EU+ countries after at least 14 days from the application of the last dose (it is necessary to have digital EU certificate – Covid Pass / Green Pass).
  - Czech citizens and EU+ citizens fully vaccinated in a third country with the EMA approved vaccination after at least 14 days from the application of the last dose (it is necessary to have a certificate whose sample is published on the Ministry of Health's website)
