

Synopsis

As a prison letter examiner, ZAKIR'S (30) job is to black out objectionable content from the inmates' incoming and outgoing mail. In his free time, he attends a course where pursues writing, his secret passion, and builds a social life. When the teacher asks the class to write a short story based on a photograph, Zakir steals one of the dozens found the inmates' letters. He uses the photo of an inmate and his attractive wife taken in the prison visitation hall to compose a story that the whole class enjoys. One day he runs into the woman from the photo as she visits her husband. He witnesses something that makes him realize that her story is more complex than he imagined. He soon tries to uncover all he can about her life. His fascination becomes an obsession, causing him to neglect his work and break the rules. As he delves into her world, he comes to disturbing realizations about her and himself. That's when the mundane life in the home he shares with his mother and the prison begins to change.

ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

Director's Statement by Serhat Karaaslan

For the last few years, I have been in correspondence with one of my relatives, a political prisoner. I knew that my letters were being monitored by officials in prison but I did not think much about it. One day, however, I noticed that many lines from the letter were scratched out. When I visited my relative, I asked him why he had done this. He replied that it was not him, but probably the letter commission who had censored something they had found objectionable. Following that conversation, all "PASSED" stamps on letters I received drew my attention. I realized that I felt like I was being monitored by someone every time I wrote letters. Maybe that feeling led me to practice self-censorship, a thought that disturbed me. So, I developed a strong curiosity about the people in that commission who read all those letters. Who are they? What kind of lives do they lead? What kind of stories do they read in the inmates' letters?

Serhat Karaaslan was born in 1984 in Varto. Turkey. He moved to Istanbul to study at the Faculty of Pharmacology at Istanbul University. After his graduation, he started to work as a Pharmacist and make short films. He was then accepted to the master's program for Directors of Film & Drama at Kadir Has University. He made two more shorts "Bicycle" and "Musa" while earning his master's degree. His latest short film "Ice Cream" premiered at the Toronto Film Festival Short Cuts Competition in 2014. His short films have won more than sixty awards and screened in major film festivals including Toronto. Locarno. Montpellier, Thessaloniki, Sarajevo and Istanbul. His first feature film project "Passed by Censor" has been selected for Cannes' Cinéfondation Residence in 2015.
